

## About Orangutans

Orangutans are the only great ape found in Asia. Their range is now confined to the rainforests of Borneo and Sumatra. They are the largest arboreal mammals in the world. Orangutans are primarily fruit-eaters and travel throughout the forest in search of ripe fruit. These primates reproduce slowly, with one offspring born approximately every eight years. Rampant deforestation, fires and the illegal pet trade have drastically reduced the population of wild orangutans. Literally hanging on in rainforest remnants, the remaining orangutans are further threatened by poaching, mechanized logging, human habitation and the rapid expansion of palm oil plantations.



## About the Orangutan Conservancy

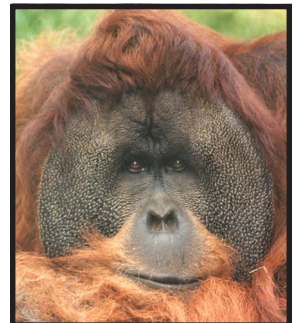
